**Outbreak of Influenza Like Illness Infection in Class 4B**

Dear Parents,

Since three students in Class 4B have symptoms of Influenza Like Illness (for example: cough, sore throat and fever, etc.) and asked for leave, the school reported to the Center for Health Protection and the Education Bureau. According to instructions from the Centre for Health Protection, some special measures are taken for Class 4B until June 4. If the school receives further guidance from the Education Bureau or Centre for Health Protection, we will notify students and parents as soon as possible.

In order to prevent the spread of Influenza Like Illness infection in our school, the school will take the following special measures:

- (1) 4B students and relevant staff must wear surgical masks on the school campus;
- (2) The school will use 1:49 bleach to disinfect 4B classroom everyday, as well as the school bus that the students take;
- (3) 4B students are not allowed to use special rooms, storybooks, toys and drinking fountains. Parents are requested to prepare enough drinking water for their children every day;
- (4) 4B students will not be able to participate in the Saturday interest classes on June 3; and
- (5) It is recommended that all P.4 students and relevant staff wear surgical masks on the school campus to reduce the risk of infection.

We recommend that parents should always pay attention to the health status of their children. Before going to school, they must take their children's body temperature. If parents find that their child has symptoms of Influenza Like Illness infection, including fever (mouth temperature higher than 37.5°C, or ear temperature higher than 38°C), cough and sore throat, etc., you must ask for leave for your child and allow your child to stay at home while seeking medical advice as soon as possible. Parents are also advised to arrange for their children to do the Rapid test for Covid-19 to ensure safety, and inform the school as soon as possible after being informed of the test results. Please take contingency measures.

The school reminds students to pay attention to personal hygiene. You may wish to refer to the CHP's guidelines on proper hand hygiene and proper use of mask, which are accessible at the CHP webpage.
