	However, this visa exemption does not apply to holders of Hong Kong SAR Documents of	
	Identity (DOI) who do need to apply for an entry visa before traveling to Singapore. Please,	
	however, check the expiry date of the passport and HK ID card, and if your child's passport	
	expires soon, please arrange a renewal as soon as possible.	
Food	Halal or Vegetarian diet (to avoid violating the immigration policy, no food should be packed	
	in luggage)	
Accommodation	Hotel or hostel (2 students per room, room arrangement will be assigned by teachers)	
Remarks	(1) If for unseen circumstances the trip is cancelled, all payments will be refunded.
